

Chairman's Report – March 2024

Kerosene in ditch in Long Street

The agency is awaiting a remediation report from their technical team, which will inform the next steps to be taken. The Chairman will update the PC at a future meeting.

Foul-water pollution in Long Street

The pump at the pumping station at Shruggs Lane had burned out. It was replaced by Anglian Water with one which is 3 times as powerful and hopefully will clear the system. This pump will have to be substituted with a normal sized one, to prevent issues downstream. Anglian Water have promised to monitor the situation closely. The surroundings of the pumping station have been cleared. Anglian Water has agreed to take an holistic review of the village's sewerage infrastructure.

Highway Safety Proposals

The two proposals made to NCC Highways are yet to be judged. The local Highways Engineer has confirmed he is pushing for a decision.

New Village Hall

A meeting took place with the NCC Early Years and Placement Executives to discuss the proposed development of Pre-school and Reception accommodation within the Primary School Grounds.

Traffic Calming near 8 Acres & West Carr Road

NCC Highways have agreed to analyse the issues in this part of the village and come up with feasible recommendations. The Chairman will expand on this at the April PC meeting.
