



Great Ellingham Parish Council Grant Awarding Policy

To qualify for an award the applicant must be able to demonstrate that funding from the Parish Council will benefit the civil parish or residents of the civil parish.

Grant applications will be dealt with at full council and council will refer to the following guidelines:

- Grants will not be awarded to individuals.
- The award must be used for the purpose for which the application was made.
- If the group is unable to use the award for the purpose stated, all monies must be returned to the parish council.
- All awards must be properly accounted for and evidence of expenditure should be supplied if requested.
- Only one application will be considered in each 12-month period, per organisation.
- Requests for donations from registered charities undertaking general appeals for funding will not be considered, with the exception of village-based charities.

Eligibility

- Any charity, voluntary group or community organisation
