

Notice of The Norfolk County Council (Surface Dressing - South Area)
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026 - Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act
1984 (RTRA 1984)

Norfolk County Council proposes to make the Surface Dressing - South Area Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (STRO14449) to facilitate surface dressing works affecting:

- 1) **B1108 Hingham Road / Norwich Road / Watton Road** from its junction with the U71430 Ironside Way to its junction with the C166 Low Road ("Road C")
- 2) **B1077 Attleborough Road** from its junction with the C135 The Street to its junction with the U33143 Bow Street ("Road H")
- 3) **B1077 Buckenham Road** from its junction with the U33090 Burgh Common to its junction with the U33083 Fen Street ("Road I")
- 4) **B1077 Attleborough Road** from its junction with the U33090 Burgh Common to its junction with the U33083 Fen Street ("Road J")
- 5) **B1077 Haugh Road** from its junction with the B1113 Castle Hill Road to its junction with the B1134 Heath Road ("Road K")
- 6) **B1113 The Turnpike** from its junction with the C350 Upgate Street to its junction with the C351 Rode Lane ("Road L")

The Roads A–CC will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated on:

- i. Road C between 19:00 – 05:00 on the 18th May, 8th and 22nd June 2026;
- ii. Road H between 19:00 – 05:00 on the 1st June, 10th and 25th June 2026;
- iii. Roads I and J between 19:00 – 05:00 on the 2nd and 26th June 2026 and 18:00 – 00:00 on the 13th June 2026;
- iv. Road K between 19:00 – 05:00 on the 3rd, 15th and 30th June 2026;
- v. Road L between 19:00 – 05:00 on the 4th and 16th June and 1st July 2026;

but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 30th September 2026 where the closure/restriction are still required beyond the anticipated dates. Alternative routes will be displayed on site. The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council. Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A–CC where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closures are no longer necessary or otherwise on the 30th September 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restrictions could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closures imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start dates being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

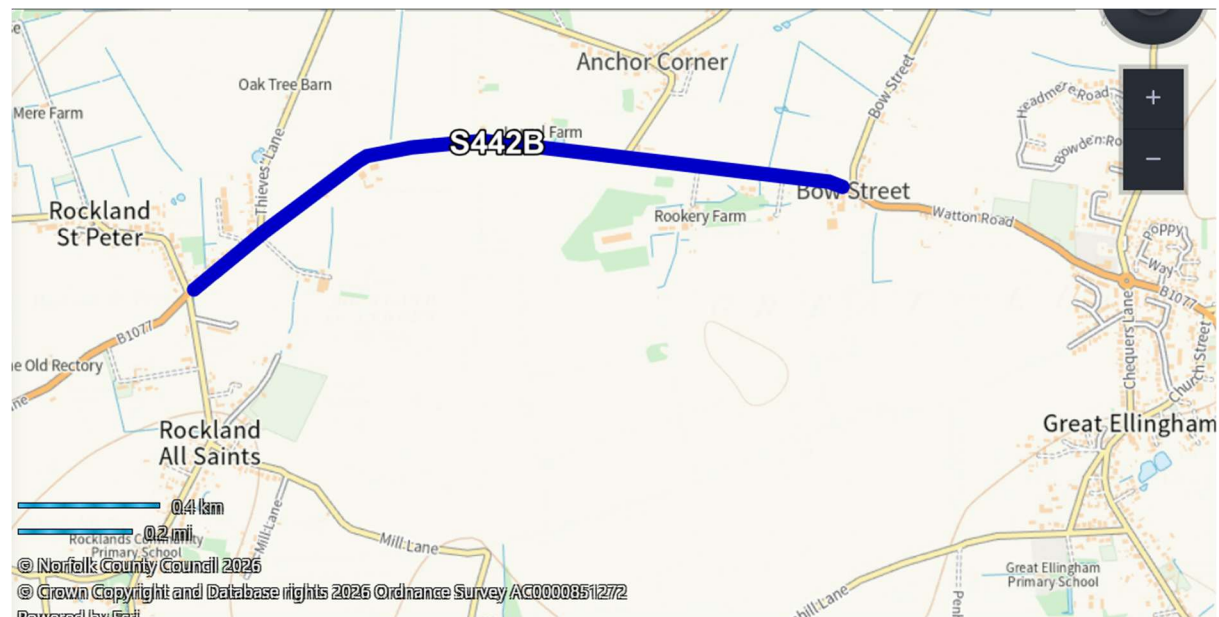

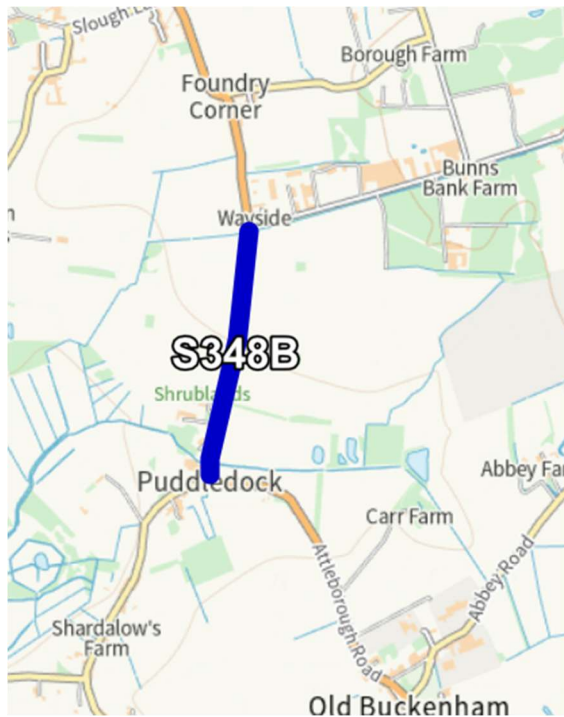
Road H, B1077 Attleborough Road



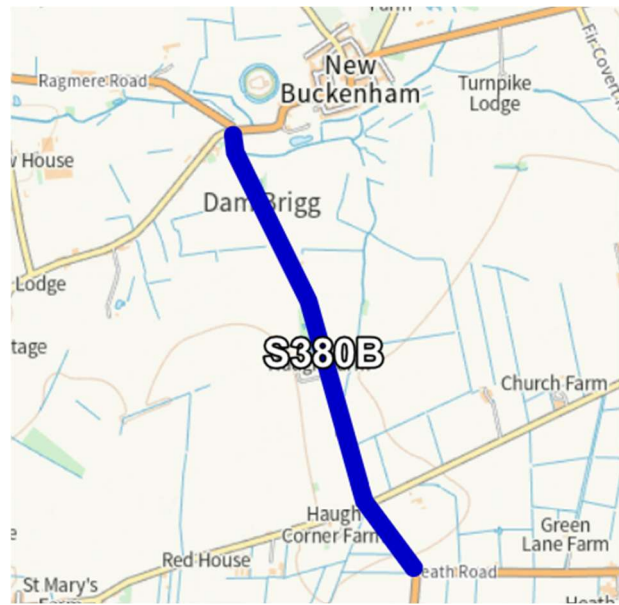
Road I, B1077 Buckenham Road
